WHAT IS THE 21ST CENTURY SCHOLARSHIP?

- Pays up to 100% tuition at Indiana two- and four-year public institutions
- Pays partial tuition at approved private or proprietary colleges
 - Private: Pays average cost of 4-year public colleges (\$8,567 for 2019/20 school year)
 - Proprietary: Pays equivalent cost of Ivy Tech Community College (\$4,501 for 2019/20 school year)
- Pays toward tuition and regularly-assessed fees
 - Room and board, textbooks, lab fees, etc. are <u>NOT</u> included
- Provides up to 4 years of tuition assistance toward an undergraduate degree
- Must access within 1 year of graduating from high school



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen
- Be an Indiana resident
- Be enrolled in the 7th or 8th grade at an Indiana school accredited by the Indiana Department of Education
 - Children in foster care may apply after the 8th grade
 - Homeschooled students are not eligible
- Meet family income guidelines
 - Children in foster care and students under legal guardianship are exempted from meeting the income guidelines

21ST CENTURY SCHOLAR PLEDGE

✓ Graduate from a state-accredited high school with a minimum of a Core 40 diploma and a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

✓ File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by April 15th as a high school senior and each year thereafter until you graduate from college.

✓ Apply to an eligible Indiana college as a high school senior, and enroll in college as a full time student within one year of high school graduation.



21ST CENTURY SCHOLAR PLEDGE CONTINUED...

- ✓ Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards established by your college.
- ✓ Complete 30 credit hours each 12-month-year you are in college to stay on track toward earning your degree on time.
- ✓ Do not use illegal drugs, commit a crime or delinquent act, or consume alcohol before reaching the legal drinking age.
- ✓ Complete the Scholar Success Program (SSP), which includes activities at each grade level in high school AND college.



Apply your student for the 21st Century Scholars Program

Indiana's 21st Century Scholars program offers income-eligible Hoosier students up to four years of paid tuition at an eligible Indiana college or university after they graduate from high school, dependent upon financial need. In middle and high school, Scholars are connected to programs and resources to help them stay on track for college and career success. Once in college, Scholars receive support to complete their college degrees and connect to career opportunities.

7th and 8th grade Indiana students whose families meet income eligibility guidelines can apply to become a 21st Century Scholar. Applications must be received by June 30 of the student's 8th grade year.

FINANCIAL MEANS TESTING

...WHAT IS IT?

Scholars enrolled AFTER June 30, 2011, must demonstrate financial need their senior year of high school and all subsequent years in college

Income threshold will be based on the Household Income on the FAFSA

Note: income amounts are different at enrollment vs. college!

Students who do NOT demonstrate need in the senior year of high school will be eligible for a one-time scholarship -- up to \$2,500
