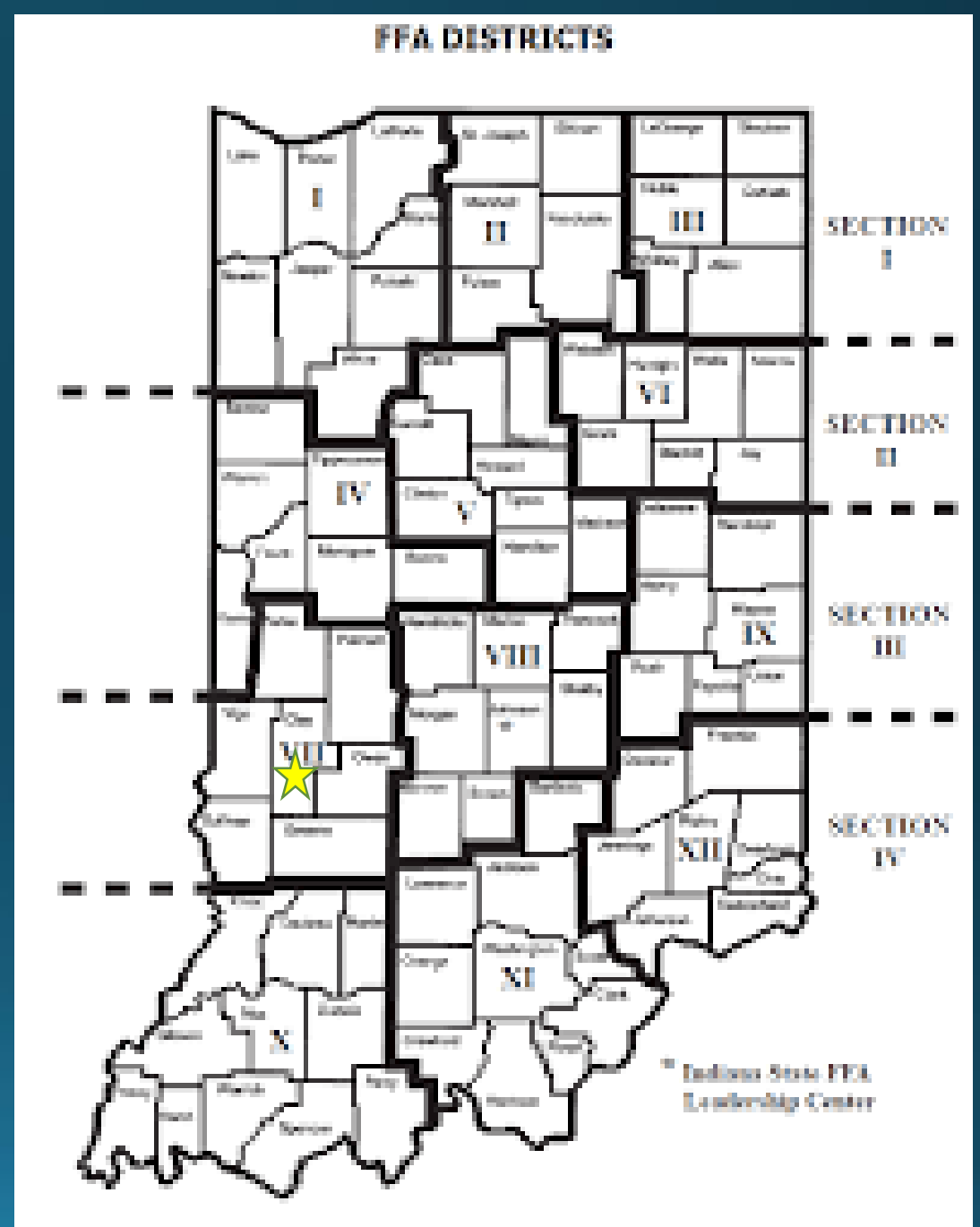
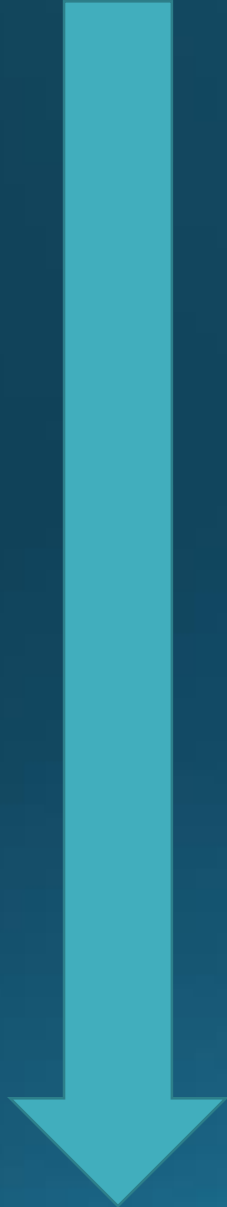

# Active Membership Requirements

- Be enrolled in the 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades
- Take an agricultural education course during the year of his or her membership (including summer SAE)
- Follow the FFA Code of Ethics and the ideals of the National FFA Organization
- *REQUIRED: Online FFA Waiver- will be sent in an email (needs to be done yearly)*
- **TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AWARDS AND DEGREES**
  - Maintain a C average in your classes
  - Participate in at least one FFA Career or Leadership Development Event (i.e. Forestry, Livestock Judging, Public Speaking, Quiz Bowl, Soils, etc.)
  - Attend a minimum of 50% of the chapter meetings
  - Attend at least 1 FFA week activity

# DUES COLLECTION

- To be an active member, you must pay the required state and national dues (\$50) by Oct. 1<sup>th</sup>.
- The chapter roster is due by October 15<sup>th</sup>, so you must be a paying member by the 8<sup>th</sup> if you plan to participate in any events or on any teams.

# Official Dress- Jacket

The most recognizable symbol of the organization is the blue corduroy FFA jacket that is worn by current FFA members.

FFA members are required to wear the FFA jacket as part of official dress while participating in all official organization activities.

Official dress is not required for meetings, recreation, etc., but is required for camps, conventions, and some contests.



# Official Dress

For females, official dress consists of a **black skirt** (black **slacks** may be appropriate for traveling and outdoor activities), a white collared **blouse**, an official FFA blue **scarf**, black dress shoes with a closed heel and toe, black nylon **hosiery**, and an official FFA jacket zipped to the top.

Male official dress includes black **dress pants**, a white dress shirt, an official FFA tie, black dress shoes with a closed heel and toe, black socks and an official FFA jacket zipped to the top.
