

# FIRST GRADE FOCUS

## Reading Foundational Skills

1.RF.4.1: We know what sound(s) each letter in the alphabet makes. We know that some letters are blended together to make new sounds (sh, ay, wr, oo, etc.) We can read and write these "hunks and chunks."

1.RF.5: We can read a first grade text or story aloud smoothly and accurately.

1.RF.4.4: We can read first grade Fry (sight) words.

1.RF.4.3: We can read and write common vowel teams (ai, oa, ee, etc.)

## Reading Literature

1.RL.3.1: We can identify the basic characteristics of fairy tales, nursery rhymes, and fiction books.

## Reading Nonfiction

1.RN.3.2: We can tell how some different nonfiction texts are structured, such as sequential, or cause and effect.

## Vocabulary

1.RV.3.1: We can find words in poems or stories that appeal to the senses (sight, taste, sound, smell, and touch).

## Writing

1.W.2.1: We can write all upper and lowercase letters correctly.

1.W.6.2c: We can spell words phonetically (sound by sound) as well as spell Fry (sight) words.

1.W.3.1: We can write to try to convince to do something.

1.W.6.1b: We can write complete sentences (asking, telling, and exclaiming).

1.CA.1: We can add and subtract fluently within 20.

1.CA.2: We can solve addition and subtraction word problems within 20.

## Geometry

1.G.1: We can tell if objects are 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional. We know which 2-D shapes make up the faces of 3-D shapes.

1.G.2: We know what defines a shape (number of sides) and what doesn't (color or size).

1.G.3: We can use 2-D and 3-D shapes to create new shapes.
