

FIRST GRADE FOCUS

Reading Foundational Skills

1.RF.4.1: We know what sound(s) each letter in the alphabet makes. We know that some letters are blended together to make new sounds (sh, ay, wr, oo, etc.) We can read and write these "hunks and chunks."

1.RF.5: We can read a first grade text or story aloud smoothly and accurately.

1.RF.4.4: We can read first grade Fry (sight) words.

1.RF.4.5: We can decode one-syllable words, such as *cat, car, rain, make*.

Reading Literature

1.RL.4.2: We can compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of characters in stories.

Reading Nonfiction

1.RN.4.2: We can tell what is the same and what is different about two different texts on the same topic.

Writing

1.W.2.1: We can write all upper and lowercase letters correctly.

1.W.6.2c: We can spell words phonetically (sound by sound) as well as spell Fry (sight) words.

1.CA.2: We can solve addition and subtraction word problems within 20.

Measurement

1.M.2: We can tell and write time to the HOUR using digital and analog clocks. We can relate time to events by using words such as *before/after, shorter/longer*.

1.G.4: We can divide circles and rectangles into two equal parts; we can describe the parts using terms *halves, fourths, and quarters*. We can tell how much of a circle or rectangle is shaded using the terms *halves, fourths, and quarters*.
