Homework

It is very important that students are completing their homework and returning it to school. A lot of the skills we are reviewing on homework are to help prepare for upcoming testing. All homework, including 20 minutes of reading, are included in student's grades.

This Week's Focus

Reading- For Unit 10, we will be focusing on comparing and contrasting texts. We will use a Venn diagram to determine how different texts are alike and different. We will also be working on making inferences and predictions about texts we are reading.

Language- For Unit 10, we will focus on subject and predicates. Students will learn to pull apart a sentence to determine the subject and predicate.

Writing- We are going to be working on persuasive writing for the third 9 weeks of school. We will primarily be doing that in class, but some of our completed writings will be coming home.

Math- For Unit 10, we will be focusing on geometry. Students will learn shape names, attributes, create two-dimensional shapes with a ruler, and partition shapes into equal areas.
