### *Math:*

\*groups of tens and ones ( $13 = \text{ten} + 3 \text{ ones}$ ); review numbers to 20

\*decomposing 10 ( $5+5=10$ ,  $4+6=10$ )

\*one more, one less (up to 20)

\*2D shapes (flat shapes) and 3D shapes (solid shapes)

### *Extra Notes:*

\*Please make sure you are sending your child's green folder to school each day. It helps with communication between home and school.

\*Don't forget to check the snack calendar for your child's day.

\*After reading ten books with your child, sign and return the January Book-It chart to receive a certificate for a free personal pan pizza from Pizza Hut.
