Reading:

Theme: Going Places

This week's letter/s: short /a/ and short /i/ word families

This week's sight word/s: she, see, look *Each week you will receive new sight words in a baggy inside your child's green folder to practice. The students must know these words before first grade!

Vocabulary words: character, setting

Stories for the week

Classroom stories: *Stellaluna & Monster Goose Nursery Rhymes*: identify characters, setting, plot, fiction/nonfiction, the role of author and illustrator, and story book or nursery rhyme?

Take home story: *We Like It!* (This story will not come home until next Friday so we can practice reading it at school this week.

Please read this story with your child. A new one will come home each week on Fridays.)

Math:

*counting by ones (goal is to 100)

*writing and recognizing numbers 0-10 (some are working on numbers 11-20)

*counting to 10 with one-to-one correspondence

*addition up to 10 using pictures or objects to count

Extra Notes:

*Please remember to return your child's eLearning packet.

*I am working on getting the report cards ready for parent/teacher conferences. Some things you can practice at home would be: writing and recognizing letters and numbers to 10 (they must recognize letters and numbers out of order), sight words, colors, and shapes.

Parents are welcome to come, but will need to drive separately due to limited space on the bus. The cost will be \$5 per student which you can send in with their permission slip.
