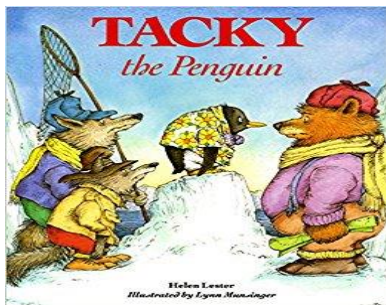




- We will learn what the vowels are!

away	give	little
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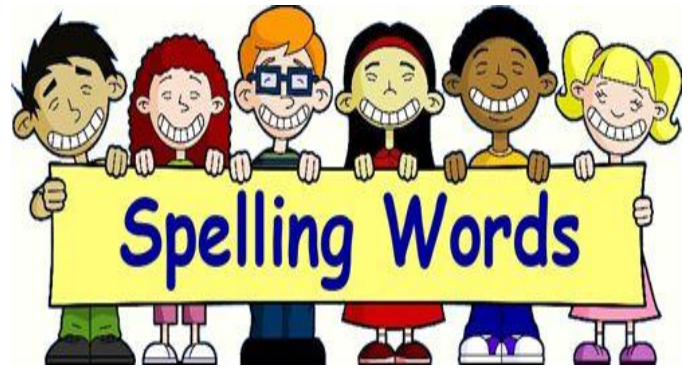
- Our “story of the week” is TACKY THE PENGUIN by Helen Lester.

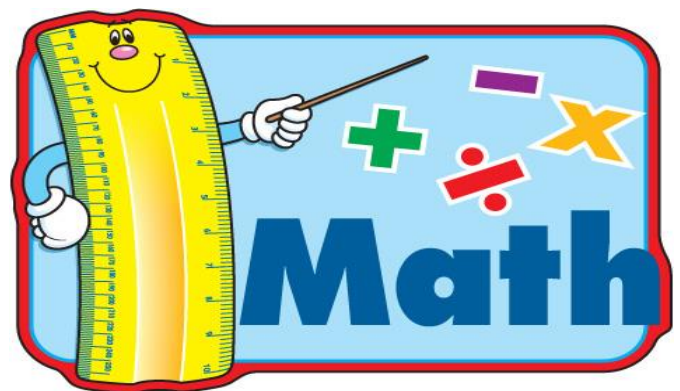
Why do kindergarten students have spelling tests?
