


• We will INTRODUCE these sight words:

- We will continue to read each day in small groups. We will encourage students to use the following strategies to <u>read words</u>...
 - 1. We will be "stretchy snakes" and stretch out sounds in words.
 - 2. We will be "chunky monkeys" and look for chunks in the words (example: S-am=Sam... we know the chunk "am").
 - 3. We will be "<u>lips the fish</u>" and get our lips ready to read by reading the first sound in the word.
 - 4. We will have "eagle eyes" and look at the pictures to give us clues what the word may be.
 - 5. We will be "skippy frog" and skip the word if we do not know it. We will come back to the word after we have read the other words around it and try to figure out what the word is.








If you get all of the words correct on Wednesday, you will receive a "challenge list" to practice for Friday!
