Tuesday- count by 1's to 50, addition

Wednesday- count by 1's to 100

Thursday- length & width

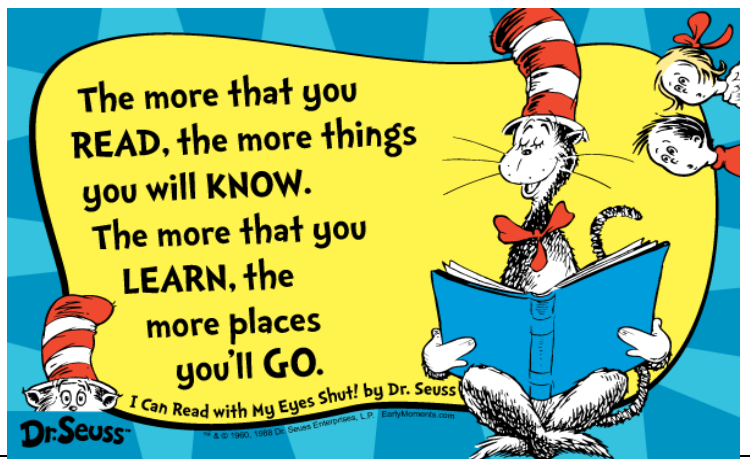
Friday- activities of ways to count to 100
