Curriculum

Reading: We will be reading Weslandia/The Circuit. The reading skill is compare/contrast point of view. We will have a quiz on Friday over the reading skill and vocabulary. The vocabulary words are: miserable, thrilling, recover, instinctively, and savoring.

Language: We will be working on progressive verb tenses. We will have a quiz on Friday.

Spelling: We will have a test on Friday over the following words: hazard, vanish, modern, rival, pilot, novel, proper, vivid, cubic, final, savage, balance, result, vapor, student, habit, credit, decent, humor, and focus.

Health: We will begin Ch. 2 this week.

Math: Saxon Lessons 68–70 , Green workbook– Ch. 8 Lesson 3–7. There will be a Saxon Test on Friday. We will be covering equivalent fractions; simplifying fractions, long division with remainders, comparing fractions; millimeters; and fraction word problems.
