## <u>Curriculum</u>

<u>Reading:</u> We will be reading <u>Weslandia/The Circuit</u>. The reading skill is compare/contrast point of view. We will have a quiz on Friday over the reading skill and vocabulary. The vocabulary words are: miserable, thrilling, recover, instinctively, and savoring.

<u>Language:</u> We will be working on progressive verb tenses. We will have a quiz on Friday.

<u>Spelling:</u> We will have a test on Friday over the following words: hazard, vanish, modern, rival, pilot, novel, proper, vivid, cubic, final, savage, balance, result, vapor, student, habit, credit, decent, humor, and focus.
