## Curriculum

Reading: We will be reading Rare Treasures. The skill for the story is main idea and details. We will have a quiz on Friday over the skill and the vocabulary. The vocabulary words: poverty, pursued, treacherous, remarkable, assembled. We will also be working on synonyms/antonyms.
