Don loved Clay City, the local businesses, school, the summertime fair, and most of all, the people. He generously donated time and money to make the community better. Don was awarded the Clay City High School Distinguished Alumni award in 1999. Upon learning of this honor, he remarked "how can this go to me, I didn't even go to college". They assured him it was for someone who made a difference, college was not a requirement. Marilyn, Don's wife, passed away in March 2021. Don was the love of her life as they were married for over 50 years.
