** To be considered, candidates must reside in Indiana or Illinois and have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, a 1270 SAT (*Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math*) or a 27 ACT, and reside in a rural community. Student evaluation will focus on the test scores, high school GPA, rural background, and interest in rural medicine.

*** To be considered, candidates must have one of the following: cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale OR an 1140 SAT (*Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math*) or 23 ACT OR ranking in the top 15% of their senior class.
