MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Stanley V. Hart Memorial Scholarship was established in 2004 by friends, family and business associates of Mr. Hart. Mr. Hart served on many boards and committees for different organizations, one of them being the school board for the Clay Community School Corporation. During his time as a school board member, Mr. Hart realized there were very few scholarships available for the student who had average to good grades and he felt very strongly that financial assistance should also be offered to these students. This scholarship was established to help such a student.

To qualify for this one-time, non-renewable scholarship a student must not be in the top ten percent of their graduating class, will be attending a two or four year college or university, and submit an essay of 250 words or less entitled "What I can do to give back to my community." The number and amount of scholarships will be determined on an annual basis.
