The Wabash Valley Herb Society, Inc., is pleased to announce that we will be awarding Martha Daniel-Joan Stevenson-Marty Mertens Memorial Scholarships in the amount of \$1000 for the 2024-2025 academic year. These scholarships are available to high school seniors, college students and adults who wish to pursue a course of study in an herb-related field. It is being offered to students who have attended a high school in the Wabash Valley or intending to attend a university, college or a vocational-technical school in the Wabash Valley. The Wabash Valley includes Vigo, Clay, Sullivan, Vermillion, Parke, Green and Putnam counties in Indiana; Edgar, Clark and Vermillion counties in Illinois. Students may re-apply each school year. The maximum number of scholarships an individual may receive is limited to 4 years (consecutive or non-consecutive).

The scholarship is offered in a variety of career majors, such as medicine, journalism, culinary arts, restaurant management, agriculture, nutrition, pharmacy, etc. The deadline for applications is March 15, 2024. A personal interview may be requested.

NOTE: Scholarship recipients and their families are invited to attend an awards meeting of the Wabash Valley Herb Society the second Wednesday of July. A scholarship check will be awarded at this meeting.

We also ask that you spend some time getting experience with herbs, and avail yourself of the knowledge of the Wabash Valley Herb Society members by joining us in presenting the Spring Thyme Plant and Herb Faire. This is held every year on the Saturday before Mother's Day at the Vigo County Fairgrounds in Terre Haute, IN.
