

Vance P. "Pat" Wiram Memorial Scholarship Application

The Vance P. "Pat" Wiram Memorial Scholarship was created in 1997 in memory of Pat Wiram, a certified geologist who volunteered at several Clay County Community Schools by conducting field trips, judging science fairs, assisting with 4H projects, and working with high school science clubs. This memorial scholarship is administered by Mr. Wiram's immediate family and will be awarded annually. The scholarship is a one-time award of \$500.

Applicants should meet the following criteria:

- Senior at Clay City High School
- 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA
- Intend to pursue a degree in science or a science-intensive field

Examples of appropriate majors include, but are not limited to the following: Environmental Science, Chemistry, Biology, Geology, Geography, Nursing and related Health Careers, Pre-Med, Pre-Vet, Pre-Pharmacy, and Pre-Physical Therapy.

An applicant's academic record, career objectives, and extracurricular activities will also be considered by the committee. Applicants must provide one letter of recommendation from a person that can speak to the student's academic performance, career interest, community/school involvement, and character. Letters of recommendation can be written by a teacher, coach, employer, extracurricular sponsor, minister, or community leader.
