As you begin your senior year, here are a few things you should do in the fall.

- Begin or continue researching your post-graduation options. Also, add your activities, work experience, and volunteer experiences to your Indiana Career Explorer résumé.

- Speak with a military recruiter, if you plan to enlist, or an apprenticeship program coordinator
- Take the SAT and ACT if you haven't already or if you need to improve your scores for admissions
 or scholarship purposes. Register online at www.sat.collegeboard.org and www.actstudent.org
- College Go Week is **September 24-28**. Some colleges offer application fee waivers during that week. Check out the Learn More Indiana website for more information.
- Apply to 3-5 schools by mid-October.
- Visit colleges which you are considering attending, sign up to meet with representatives in the Counseling Office
- Send your transcripts to colleges electronically through Parchment. Go to the CCHS
 Counseling website and click on the "How to Order Transcripts" tab
- Register with the NCAA Clearinghouse if you plan to play Division I or II athletics www.eligibilitycenter.org
- Research scholarship opportunities. Scholarships offered will be listed on the CCHS Counseling website. Additional scholarships are available through the search engines and specific college admission websites.
- Apply for your Federal Student Aid ID at https://fsaid.ed.gov in order to electronically sign your FAFSA. Your parent will also need to establish an FSA ID. You can start filing your FAFSA on October 1 (https://fafsa.gov). Additional financial aid information is available on our web page. Be sure to file the FAFSA by the April 15 deadline.
