Literacy/Language Arts

The website explains this activity clearly. You don't have to use sticky notes. Just a small piece of paper with the letter written on it will do. Also, don't feel like students have to do all the letters of the alphabet. Just help them find as many as they can in 10 minutes or so. If they love it and wish to continue working past the 10-minute mark that is great! I would love to see pictures!
