## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

### CHANCELLOR'S AWARD SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

- For high school graduates with a 3.5 cumulative GPA or in the top 10% of the class
- Covers the full cost of tuition, technology fees, and books for four semesters
- Must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Must enroll in at least 12 credit hours of Ivy Tech coursework each semester

### ACADEMIC/TECHNICAL HONORS SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

- For high school graduates with an Academic Honors or Technical Honors diploma
- \$750 a semester
- Renewable for four semesters
- Must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Must enroll in at least 6 credit hours of Ivy Tech coursework each semester

### LAPTOP SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

- Can be awarded in addition to other scholarships
- Selection based on essay questions, high school GPA, dual credit, and Ivy Tech GPA if applicable.
