Our youth summer design workshop allows students to experience interior design hands-on.

Why our workshops?

- Explore the field of interior design to find out if it is right for you!
- Prepare for college-level interior design courses and get a head start on fundamental concepts
- Start building your portfolio, which is an important tool while searching for jobs

During the workshop, students will get the chance to explore the fundamentals of both 2D and 3D concepts, learn basic drawing and illustration skills, play with the effects of color and lighting, and learn how interior environments impact overall human behavior.

By the end of the workshop, students will walk away with new friends, gain new perspectives of design, and a personal portfolio displaying their work.

We offer a total of three workshops, two online and two in person. If you or anyone you know has an interest in pursuing interior design at the college level, this is the workshop for you! Each workshop is limited to 12 students, so be sure to apply early to secure your spot in the workshop session of your choice!

Can't make it to campus?

Our online workshop is held virtually using Canvas, Zoom, and/or Webex. Canvas is a password-protected online environment used for submitting work and communicating with the professor and fellow students using discussion boards, chat rooms, and centralized email. Webex and Zoom allows everyone to meet wherever they are in the comfort of their own space. Each of these resources will require a computer with Internet access. After each day of the workshop, there will be a variety of planned activities for the students to get the chance to experience what the college life is like on campus.
